- ☒ **Online Dictionaries and Translators:** Tools like Google Translate, Linguee, and Merriam-Webster provide quick translations and definitions, aiding in vocabulary building and comprehension.

- ❑ **Virtual Reality (VR) and Augmented Reality (AR):** VR and AR applications create immersive language learning environments, allowing learners to practice in realistic scenarios.

Language Skills for Effective Communication

- For you to communicate effectively, there are requisite skills that you need to develop and these cover all four modes of communication: speaking, Listening, writing and reading
- SPEAKING SKILLS**
 - clear articulation of thoughts, ideas and messages
 - correct pronunciation of words, phrases and sentences to convey meaning
 - Fluency – speak smoothly, naturally and at a comfortable pace
 - Effective use of body language- facial expressions, postures, gestures and eye contact to convey emotions and attitudes
 - Regulating the tone of voice as necessary- deploying pitch and volume to convey emotions and emphasis

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Writing Skills

- ☒ Write clearly and concisely to convey your thoughts, ideas and messages
- ☒ Correctly spell words to convey meaning
- ☒ Use correct grammar, punctuation, and sentence structures
- ☒ Use specialised terminologies relevant to a specific field or industry when engaging in technical writing (i.e. word register)

READING SKILLS

- ☒ Read to understand written texts including emails, reports and documents
- ☒ Understand the meaning of words or phrases
- ☒ Scanning- enables you to quickly locate specific information within texts
- ☒ Skimming- enables you to rapidly read a text to gain a general understanding
- ☒ Seek clarification or additional information, do not just assume

LISTENING SKILLS

- ☒ Attention- focus on the speaker and filter out distractions
- ☒ Understand the speaker's perspective and respond appropriately
- ☒ Recognise tone and inflexion (this can help recognise the speaker's emotion and attitude)
- ☒ You should be able to paraphrase and summarise the speaker's message after the listening exercise
- ☒ You should be able to provide feedback by responding with verbal or non-verbal cues
